



Professional Experience Placements for those with Special Authority to Teach

Accredited Initial Teacher Education (ITE) Programs are required to offer Professional Experiences for preservice teachers. All ITE Programs have requirements which they were accredited against the National Program Standards, by a Sub-Committee of the Teachers Registration Board of South Australia.

To ensure the accreditation requirements are sufficiently met, the Board requires reporting from each ITE provider for all preservice teachers undertaking professional experience placements while holding a Special Authority to Teach.
